Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Proposed Project would be located on approximately 32.2 acres in the Port's Seaport Facility, within the City of Oakland in Alameda County in the state of California. Key roads serving the Proposed Project site include Maritime Street, 7th Street, West Grand Avenue, and Navy Roadway. The primary construction and operation entrance and exit from the Proposed Project site would be from 14th Street and Maritime Street, respectively. The Proposed Project would upgrade onsite substations; install a battery energy storage system and electric vehicle chargers; construct a Reefer Storage area and install reefer racks and plug-ins; remove, replace, and feather pavement; construct a bioretention swale; remove and install perimeter fencing; and replace high mast lighting with light-emitting diode bulbs. The purpose of the Proposed Project is to support a more efficient operation and continue progress towards meeting the Port's zero emissions goals and build resiliency to the Port's electrical infrastructure.
