Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Project proposes the construction and operation of a sewer lift station to collect and discharge wastewater from the surrounding area to the near-by sewer system that is owned and operated by the Crestline Sanitation District (CSD). Construction would involve the installation of a 566.56-foot-long sewer station and pipeline that would be located underground and run from the southwest to the northeast of the Project site. The Project would connect the valve vault to the discharge manhole CSD. The Project would also require an electrical conduit to be built underground along with the pipeline. The electrical conduit would extend from Houston Drive to the end of a dirt road approximately 500 feet northwest from Edelweiss Drive. The Project pipeline and connecting structures, along with the electrical conduit, are owned and operated by the Project applicant.

Potentially significant effects: Unforeseen nesting birds and special status species could potentially be impacted; unforeseen historical, cultural, or tribal cultural resources may be encountered during construction.

Mitigation was proposed which would implement proper nesting season construction precautions and the completion of pre-construction surveys for special status species. Mitigation was also included which would ensure proper caution was taken on the potential discovery of cultural, paleontological, tribal resources as well as human remains.
