Project Description:


The Applicant proposes to install a new one-million-gallon (MG) water storage tank and booster station with shade structure in Merced County. The Project also includes construction and installation of the following: an electrical building, chlorine building, transformer, backup generator, on-site piping.

Public Agency Approving Project: The Water System is carrying out the Project.

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Drinking Water (DDW), is the Responsible Agency for the Project. The Division of Drinking Water has approved the plans and specs for the above described Project on 07/08/2024, and has made the following California Environmental Quality Act Determinations regarding the project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to the effects within the State Water Board's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. The State Water Board has considered the Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the State Water Board's approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
6. Findings were not made by the State Water Board pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
