The project's Reporting District (RD 0118) is within the geographical boundaries of the Los Angeles Police Department's, Central Area. A project of this size could have an impact on police services within Central Area. The Department is available for advisement on crime prevention features appropriate for the design of the properties within the project.

**The following report was prepared for the “130 College Project” in accordance with Section 15083 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This report is prepared to adequately identify and assess the project’s potential public impact in accordance with Section 15083 of California State CEQA guidelines.**

**Project Location and Purpose:**

The “130 College Project” will be constructed within the boundaries of the City of Los Angeles, serving the Downtown areas of Los Angeles. The addresses covered under this project will be 114 and 130 West College Street, 119 West Bruno Street and 943, 949, 955 and 973 North Main Street.

A summarization of the project’s Environmental Impact Report (EIR) is to identify and assess the project’s potential impact on public quality of life issues and concerns and to address the projects’ impact on police response and protective services. This is in accordance with section 15083 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This EIR will also assess the projects’ potential impact on the resources needed, the resources available and the impact these services and resources will have on the immediate community.

**Description of Proposed Project:**

The proposed “130 College Project” is considered a new build. The project would have a total floor area of approximately 232,802 square feet, consisting of 224,597 square feet of usable office space. 4,095 square feet will be restaurant usage and 4,110 square feet will be of retail uses. The project would also include approximately 1,799 square feet of outdoor, uncovered dining area next to the ground floor restaurant. Because of the 1,799 square feet of uncovered restaurant dining area, the total restaurant square footage will be 5,894 square feet of restaurant space. The project would have five stories comprised of a podium build with one level of at-grade parking and one level of above-grade parking.

This build will measure 88 feet in height from grade level to the top of the mechanical penthouse. The project will have approximately 52,716 square feet of outdoor area and 440 vehicle parking space. The existing parking lot will be demolished in preparation for a surface parking lot.

**Project Distance and Times:**

The measured distances and times using Central Division Community Police Station as a starting point to 114 West College Street is approximately 1.8 miles @ 11 minutes. To 130 West College Street is approximately 1.7 miles@10 minutes. To 119 West Bruno Street is 1.7 miles@10 minutes. To 943 North Main Street is 1.9 miles@12 minutes. To 949 North Main Street is 1.8 miles@12 minutes. To 955 North Main Street is 1.8 miles@11 minutes. To 973 North Main Street is 1.7 miles@11 minutes.

These distances and times were calculated from a departure point starting from Central Division Community Police Station. The arrival times were also configured utilizing some traffic delays.

Estimated times of arrival can vary depending on divisional call load, time of the day, traffic delays and types of calls officers are responding to.

The reporting district for Central Division Community Police Station is RD 0153. Their phone number is (213) 833-3703.

**Divisional Geographic's / Demographics:**

Central Division Community Police Station's geographical area of patrol is approximately 4.5 square miles and consists of 62 Reporting Districts. The service boundaries for Central Division are as follows:

To the **West** is CA-110 Harbor Freeway, Sunset Boulevard and Douglas Street.

To the **North** is Douglas Street, Lilac Place, Vin Scully Avenue, Stadium Way, Lilac Terrace, Lookout Drive and the CA-110 Harbor Freeway.

To the **East** is CA-110 Harbor Freeway and the Los Angeles River.

To the **South** is the Los Angeles River, East 7<sup>th</sup> Street, South San Pedro, East 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Maple Avenue, Washington Boulevard and the CA-110 Harbor Freeway.

The proposed, "130 College Project", will be in ***RD 0118*** (*Los Angeles Police Department's Central Division*). The borders for ***RD 0118*** are as follows:

**Reporting District 0118:**

To the **West** is North Alameda Street, West College Street and North Broadway.

To the **North** is North Broadway and the Los Angeles River.

To the **East** is North Broadway, the Los Angeles River and Alhambra Avenue.

To the **South** is Los Angeles River, Union Pacific Rail Road, East Alhambra Avenue, Alpine Street and North Alameda Street.

**Central Division:**

Central Division has approximately 325 full time sworn personnel, 11 Sworn Reserve Police Officers and 13 civilian support staff. The Central Area of Los Angeles is a culturally diverse community, concentrated in the downtown section of Los Angeles (DTLA). Points of interest in the Downtown areas of Los Angeles consist of the downtown communities of Chinatown, Little Tokyo, South Park, Central City East, Historic Core Los Angeles, the Financial Districts, the Jewelry District, Artist Lofts, Historic Spanish Olvera Street, the Fashion District, the Los Angeles Convention Center, the Crypto Stadium and L.A. Live.

Central Division borders LAPD's Rampart Division to the west, Hollenbeck Division to the east, Newton Division to the south and Northeast Division to the north. The residential population in Central area (DTLA) is roughly 85,000 people, plus or minus. This populous can swell to over 200,000 people during the daytime hours in Downtown Los Angeles (WIKIPEDIA and the 2020 US Census).

The officer to resident ratio is 1 officer to every 252 residents (252:1). This is a given residential impact for a 5.84 square mile area that could affect Central Division's patrol duties. This population amount does not reflect citizens from outside the area visiting local businesses, churches, residences and educational institutions.

**The Los Angeles Police Department:**

The Los Angeles Police Department currently has 8,861 sworn personnel and 2,830 civilian support personnel (as of April 7, 2024). These city employees cater services to a Los Angeles City residential, Census population of approximately 3,985,516. This population amount is current as of October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 (according to 2010-2019 American Community Survey and the 2020 US Census for year 2022). Additionally, this amount does not include all residents and non-residents, but only reflects those individuals that responded to the 2020 Census.

This population equates to a resident to officer ratio of 450 residents for every 1 officer (450:1). The 3,985,516 population depicts a firm registered value of the population for the City of Los Angeles. However, this number can also be fluid.

The ethnic break down of The City of Los Angeles, according to the 2010-2019 American Community Survey and Wikipedia is:

- 46.9% Hispanic / Latin
- 28.9% White (Non-Hispanic)
- 11.7% Asian
- 8.3% Black / African American
- 0.73% Native American
- 0.16% Native Hawaiian / Pacific Islander
- 3.4% Other / two or more races

**Divisional Support and Communication:**

There are many specialized support units, divisions, sections and services available to Central Division within the LAPD i.e., Air Support, Detective investigative sections, Specialized Units, Motor Units, Bike Units, K9, Emergency Operations, Bomb Squad and Metro / SWAT, to support any additional policing needs Central Division may encounter. These services are available to supplement and complement Central's policing services. In utilizing these available resources, the Los Angeles Police Department can meet the demands for police services for the 130 College Project.

Central Community Police Station's emergency response system is directly linked to the Los Angeles Police Department's Communication and Dispatch Center. Communication Division has the responsibility to staff this Dispatch Center. The staff are incident trained personnel that will respond to radioed and telephoned calls for service. They would then dispatch these requests to the proper emergency and non-emergency personnel required or requested. Then they would provide the city personnel involved with the necessary information to execute the duties of their office for any prevailing incidents.

These operations are performed on a 24 hour a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year basis. This includes 9-1-1 emergency calls (police, fire and medical). In referencing Communication Division, their main area of concentration is the dispatching and follow-up of police calls for service. Communication Division's, "Emergency Operations Center" (EOC / DOC), also works in concert with the Los Angeles Fire Department's (LAFD), "Metropolitan Fire Communications Center" (MFC).

Additional emergency response entities that Communication Division interacts with are, but not limited to, is the Los Angeles County Fire Department (LACoFD), the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) and other regional city police and fire agencies. This interaction is performed to ensure coordinated responses to all emergencies and incidents that occurred, will occur or are occurring in the Los Angeles City and Los Angeles County regions.

**Divisional and Citywide Response Times:**

According to the Los Angeles Police Department's Computer Statistics (COMPSTAT) Division, the average police response time to emergency, high priority calls in the Central area (Code 3 calls) was 3.6 minutes (as of April 6, 2024). This was done with a dispatch median time of 1.8 minutes. The medium high priority response time (Code 2) as of April 6, 2024 was 18.4 minutes. This was done with a dispatch median time of 10.1 minutes. Low priority, non-emergency response times, as of April 6, 2024 was 46.5 minutes. These low priority calls had a dispatch median time of 26.1 minutes.

Citywide response times during this same 4-week period was 4.6 minutes for emergency, high priority calls. The dispatch median time was 1.5 minutes. The medium high priority response times were 16.8 minutes with a dispatch time of 5.1 minutes. Low priority response times were 32.3 minutes with a dispatch time of 13.5 minutes.

These response times were taken from the statistics submitted by Central Division to COMPSTAT for a 4-week period between March 10, 2024 through April 6, 2024. During this same 4-week period, Central Division answered 471 emergency calls for service, 1,864 medium high priority calls and 1,053 low priority calls.

Citywide, for the same 4-week period, the Los Angeles Police Department answered 6,611 emergency calls for service, 25,595 medium high priority calls and 19,837 low priority calls. The response times stated are adequate performance times for this police division.

**Statistics:**
