Collectively, these individual projects comprise the Proposed Project.

Component projects include, but are not limited to: improvements to and rehabilitation of campsites, restrooms, boating takeouts, marinas, on and off-lake swim areas, roads, parking lots, recreational trails, and upgrades to utilities (electrical, sewerage, water, communications).

These projects could require ground-disturbing activities up-to open trenching for installation and/or rehabilitation of underground utilities.
