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NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE PROPOSED DECOTO RESERVOIR SEISMIC IMPROVEMENTS AND ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN THE CITY OF FREMONT

Pursuant to the State of California Public Resources Code and the "Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970" as amended to date, this is to advise you that the Alameda County Water District (ACWD) has prepared a Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Decoto Reservoir Seismic Improvements and Roof Replacement Project (Project). The Project is located in the City of Fremont, Alameda County, California, southeast of Seven Hills Park, Union City.

The purpose of the Project is to replace the roof and roof framing system and seismically upgrade the Decoto Reservoir (reservoir). The proposed work includes roof replacement, replacement of the reservoir's valves and valve stem extension, replacement of the reservoir's liner, installation of a new forced air ventilation system, and installation of new interior lighting. The construction window for the Project is October 1, 2024, through March 31, 2026.
