The Location: The proposed project is in El Dorado County from Post Miles 18.7 to 21.9, 22.6 to 22.9, and 24.2 to R29.1

Project Description: The purpose of this project is to preserve and extend the service life of the existing pavement and extend the service life of drainage systems by replacing fair or poor condition systems. The project also improves safety by upgrading non-standard median concrete barriers and guardrails to the current standards, upgrading Transportation Management System (TMS) elements and signs, constructing one acceleration lane, paving beyond the gore areas, and constructing Maintenance Vehicle Pullouts (MVPs) to improve Caltrans worker safety.
