Project Title: San Bernardino Avenue Phase I_H15219

Project Location: The proposed Project is located along San Bernardino Avenue, between Cherry Avenue and Fontana Avenue/Elm Avenue, in the Fontana area. See ATTCH 2_Location Map.

Project Description: The San Bernardino County Public Works Department proposes street maintenance and minor improvements to San Bernardino Avenue. The Project includes mill and overlay of 6,653 feet of existing roadway which consists of, but is not limited to, hot mixed asphalt, painting stripes and pavement markings, installing pavement markers and other work appurtenant thereto. Utility relocation is not required. The equipment used will include, but is not limited to, road roller, loader, dump truck, paver, grinder/planer, water truck, etc. No traffic detours or nighttime construction are planned. Construction activities will occur on or adjacent to existing roads, asphalt or graded and maintained dirt shoulder. Construction duration is anticipated to be 25 working days.
