This replaces the Notice of Exemption filed 5/30/2024, to provide more specificity regarding the event.

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue a Special Event permit to Toyota Motor Sales for a special event at Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area for the purpose of Toyota staff product testing. The proposed event calls for the installation of temporary tents set on grade in the special event overflow parking area, and will have a maximum attendance of 100 people per day for five (5) days. Participants will utilize the utility gate at the south entrance at SRI trailhead, the motocross and overflow parking lots, motocross track and 4x4 play area.

All work conducted in association with the Special Event permit will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code.
