Purpose and Need

The purpose of this project is to improve safety for motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians at the Del Paso Blvd on-ramp and off-ramp. This project is needed as this location reported a higher Total Actual Collision Rate than the total statewide average rate for similar facilities. A total of 7 collisions in a 5-year period (January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2021) involving 10 injuries have been reported at this location.

All work will occur within Caltrans right of way. Construction is estimated to be 45 working days. There will be a complete ramp closure with detour.

Scope of Work:

- Replace and install safety lighting.
- Install one new streetlamp on the off-ramp.
- Trench in shoulder to an approximate depth of 30 inches.
- Trim trees.
- Add yellow reflectors on top of existing left side barrier of off-ramp.
- Update roadway striping.
- Add optical speed bars at off-ramp.
- Replace roadside signs.
- Add wrong way signs on the off-ramp.
- Seal cracked concrete slabs.
- Cold plane and overlay the roadway.
- Install 4-foot paved right shoulder on off-ramp.
- Upgrade and extend existing guardrail with Midwest Guardrail System (MGS) and install vegetation control.

Staging

Staging would occur within Caltrans right of way. Potential staging area to be adjacent to the off-ramp on existing maintenance areas.

Permit Requirements

No permits are required.
