The Vineyard One Project would include the construction and associated operation of up to 231 residential units, consisting of 193 units with 38 accessory units (ADUs), with new internal streets, supporting parking spaces and associated circulation, landscaping, bioretention and drainage features, and utility improvements. The Project's residential development would provide a variety of housing types, including townhouses, residential flats, single-family detached homes and ADUs in a total of 48 stand-alone buildings, totaling approximately 420,760 square feet of floor area including 334,898 square feet of living space and 85,862 square feet of enclosed parking. Approximately four acres of open landscaped park areas and pathways are also proposed, including 166 new trees (45 existing trees would be removed). Stormwater would be treated by a new 64,000-cubic-foot hydromodification storage vault, to be located in an approximately 14,500-square foot area at the southern tip of the Project site.
