Reasons why project is exempt:  In accordance with CEQA, the use of the Common Sense Exemption is based on the "general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment." (CEQA Guidelines, §15061(b)(3)). The project will provide a zero-emission vehicle technology training program for students, and any activities will be conducted in accordance with local and state laws and regulations, including waste disposal laws. The project is also categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to Class 1, Class 3, and Class 22 Categorical Exemption of the State CEQA Guidelines, (CEQA Guidelines, §15301, §15302, §15322). Minor alteration of an existing public facility, involving no expansion of existing use is categorically exempt (§15303), Adoption of educational and training programs that involve no physical alteration to the environment are categorically exempt. The project will also not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of categorical exemption as detailed under CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2, because the project will not cause an impact to an environmental resource of hazardous or critical concern nor does the project have unusual circumstances that could possibility have a significant effect on the environment.
