Project Title: Crestview Fuel Break Project Amendment (SNC 1200.2 & 1330.1)

**Project Location – Specific**: 18 acres of BLM land along Pine Grove Volcano Road, immediately north of the intersection with State Highway 88. Project center at approximately -120.653, 38.415 degrees.

Project Location - City: Pine Grove Project Location - County: Amador

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The Sierra Nevada Conservancy (SNC) would amend grant agreements 1200 and 1330 for the Tiger Creek Fuel Break, to authorize the Amador Fire Safe Council (AFSC) to use SNC grant funds towards implementation of the Crestview Fuel Break Project. AFSC would work with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) to implement 18 acres of fuels reduction to create a strategic shaded fuel break that would reduce high intensity fire behavior and make suppression efforts more effective. This project is located in the Wildland Urban Interface of the community of Pine Grove on BLM land. Project activities could include hand cutting/piling small diameter trees and brush for future pile burning; pruning and limbing of tree species to raise canopy base height to decrease ladder fuels; mechanical mastication of surface fuels, brush, and small trees; chipping of vegetation, lopping and scattering, and removal of vegetation offsite; manual removal of noxious weeds by pulling or cutting; and pile burning and/or understory burning to reduce residual fuel loading. Maintenance activities may include re-mastication, hand cut/pile and pile burning, grubbing of brush species, herbicide application on resprouting vegetation, and/or the use of broadcast burning. The project would include all design features and management practices as required by the National Environmental Policy Act decision approving the project.
