Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Project would install a sewer trunkline mainly in the unincorporated area outside the southern City limits. The proposed trunkline pipe diameter would range from 1.25-2.25 feet, the trench width would be 6-feet-wide, with total easements 40-feet wide. The trunkline would extend approximately 2.85 miles. Additionally, a manhole would be installed at the south end of an existing 36-inch culvert and connect a 40 foot long pipe in the existing drainage ditch to provide vehicular construction access to the P-18 Sewer Trunkline Project, and to facilitate future maintenance access to the easterly manholes located on the south side of Skyway.

Biological Resources
