**Project Title:** Bridgehouse Lane Culvert Crossing (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-47270-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at a detention basin tributary to the Cosumnes River, at 7300 Bridge House Lane, Sloughouse, CA 95683 in the County of Sacramento; Latitude 38.49579, Longitude -121.08240 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 073-0190-011-0000

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SAC-47270 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Viking Construction Company, Inc.

The project is limited to the construction of a new bridge across an existing stormwater drainage basin. It will be 18' 9" wide and approximately 98' 10" long. It will consist of three steel arch culverts with cast-in-place concrete headwalls. The two end culverts will be 23' 5" wide and the middle culvert will be 32'-2" wide. These will sit on four reinforced concrete footings (2 abutments and 2 piers) supported by 26 36" CIDH piles which will be drilled and concrete poured. The abutments will be 11' 6" wide and 21' 6" long while the piers will be 18' wide and 21' 6" long. Four retaining walls (19' 1" length and 9' 3" width) will extend from the corners of the culvert to tie into the existing basin slopes. Approximately 350 cubic yards of excavation and 200 cubic yards of backfill will be required. Formwork will also be constructed to allow for the construction of the bridge. The bridge will be on a new alignment and the approaches will tie into an existing roadway and driveway.

**Exempt Status:**

Categorical Exemption. Type – Class (3); California Code of Regulations, title 14, section (15303) and Class (4); California Code of Regulations, title 14, section (15304)

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**Reasons why project is exempt:** Project consists for a minor bridge construction on an already impacted land in a private residence that has no sensitive habitat. The project does not include the removal of healthy, mature, or scenic trees.
