DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install a vehicle charging station in the maintenance area of Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park to meet the requirements of the Department of General Services Office of Fleet and Asset Management mandating "electric vehicle chargers ratio of 1:1" that requires the number of chargers to equal the number of fleet EV vehicles. Work will:

- Excavate a 15-ft L x 3-ft D x 2-ft W area for the EV charger foundation, pull box, bollard and conduit run;
- Install two (2) 24-in W x 24-in L x 12-in D BTC Power Single Port Pedestals;
- Install surface mounted conduit along the side of the building;
- Install several bollards with 3-ft in concrete and 4-ft above ground; and
- Excavate a 1-ft W x 2-ft 6-in D hole, with 6-ft 8-in clearance from ground level, for fleet signage identifying the charging station.
