A request by Sarabjit Purewal for a Minor Use Permit/Coastal Development Permit (C-DRC2022-00025) to allow for the construction of an approximately 3,452-square-foot single-family residence with an attached 1,202-square-foot garage, 424-square-foot storage space, a 504-square-foot unconditioned art studio, and associated site improvements. The project would result in approximately 0.29 acre (12.632 square feet) of ground disturbance, including 540 cubic yards of cut and 220 cubic yards of fill on a 0.46-acre vacant parcel (Assessor's Parcel Number [APN] 074-483-009) located at the southern end of Madera Street, approximately 406 feet south of the Madera Street and San Ricardo Lane intersection, in the community of Los Osos in the Residential Single-Family (RSF) land use designation in the Estero Planning Area (Coastal Zone).
