Project Title: Shonger's Farm LLC (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 139 Autumn Court Post Mountain, CA, 96041 in Trinity County.

County: Trinity County

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code, Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a small outdoor commercial cannabis license.

Project Activities: The Project will consist of the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet (sf) of mature mixed-light cannabis located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number APN: 019-570-024-00. Existing activities include the cultivation of up to 10,000 sf of mature canopy and support infrastructure which includes a shed for generator and petroleum storage a 56 sq ft shed for agricultural chemical and pesticide storage, a 120 sq shed for harvest storage, a 1,026 sq ft processing area, and 63 sq ft compost area. Water will be provided from a groundwater well, and a permitted septic will be used for the project's wastewater needs.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is consistent with the local jurisdiction community plan and/or zoning designations. CEQA mandates that the project is consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. The project activity fits within the parameters included in CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 and the activity does not require additional CEQA analysis.
