This project will strengthen or replace existing infrastructure to improve seismic safety and functional recovery following a major seismic event.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT MAIN WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT MAINTENANCE CENTER AND SUPPORT FACILITIES SEISMIC RETROFIT PROJECT (SD-436)

Overview and Background

The East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD) Main Wastewater Treatment Plant (MWWTP) provides preliminary, primary, and secondary treatment of wastewater to protect environmental health and comply with regulations. The MWWTP Maintenance Center and Support Facilities Seismic Retrofit Project (Project) addresses life and workplace safety to minimize seismic risk to workers and the visiting public.

Project Purpose and Objectives

This project will perform work on the Maintenance Center, Field Services Building, Effluent Pump Station Entrance Canopy, Digester Gallery Roof Slab, Electrical Substations and Key Power Distribution Lines at the MWWTP. This project will strength existing structures and remove seismic hazards to improve seismic safety, minimize operational impacts, and support functional recovery following a major seismic event.

Project Location

The Project is located at the MWWTP at 2020 Wake Avenue in Oakland. All work will be completed within the existing MWWTP facility on EBMUD property. Refer to Figure 1 for the project location.

Project Characteristics

The scope of work includes the following improvements:

1. Major structural strengthening to the Maintenance Center, Field Services Building including interior and exterior strengthening and addition of structural steel elements and associated reinforced concrete foundations.
2. Major structural strengthening to the Digester Gallery Roof Slab and loading structural elements including thickening of concrete slab and additional structural steel elements.
3. Structural anchoring and bracing of Electrical Substations and Key Power Distribution Lines.
4. Removal of seismic hazards including the free-standing interior conference room in the Field Services Building, and the Effluent Pump Station Entrance Canopy. These structures will be replaced by seismic resilient interior conference room and awing respectively.
5. Associated mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and roofing work required to allow seismic retrofit strengthening and modifications and address American Disability Act (ADA) and other permit-required improvements.

Permits and Approvals

Building permits from the City of Oakland are required for the Project for the Maintenance Center and the Field Services Building.

Public Considerations

The MWWTP is on private property and located at least 2000 feet away from residential or commercial areas. Impacts to the public from construction activities will be minimal.

Schedule and Work Hours

Construction is scheduled to begin in February 2025. The estimated construction duration is approximately 30 months. Regular construction work hours are planned for 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

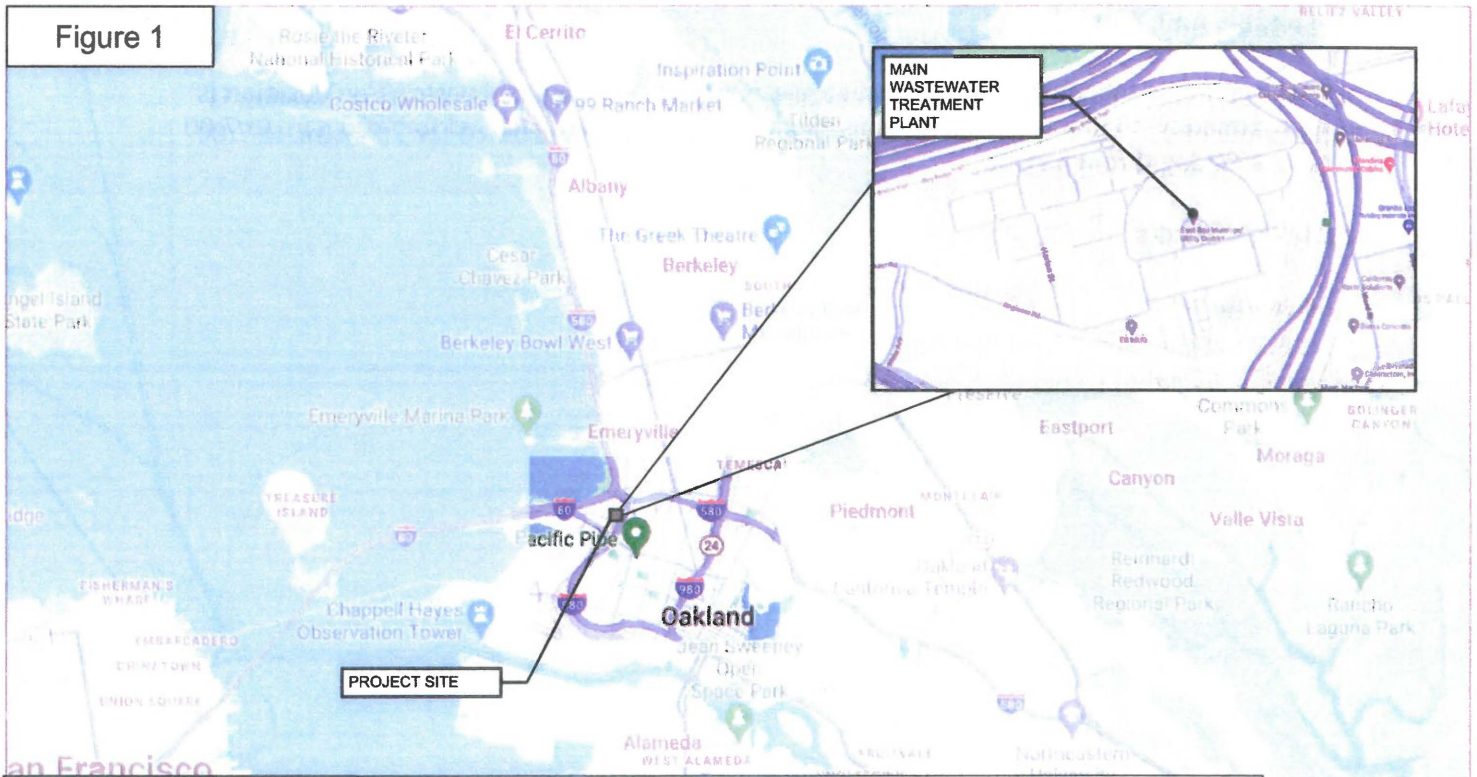
