Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The basketball courts at Taylor Middle School are in a state of disrepair. City of Millbrae Staff, along with the Millbrae Elementary School District, coordinated a construction project that would renovate the six full-court basketball courts at Taylor Middle School. The project includes removal and replacement of the asphalt concrete playing surface, new header boards, a concrete mow band, new basketball hoops, backboards, and stands, a two-color scheme for the playing surface, and striping. The project will also include the replacement of an additional 1,450 square feet of existing asphalt pavement adjacent to the court that is in poor condition.
