Project Title: Harrington Agricultural Well

Project Location: The project is located in the La Honda Creek Open Space Preserve in unincorporated San Mateo County, approximately 0.3-mile northwest of the Sears Ranch Parking Area (APN 078-290-060).

Address: 900 Sears Ranch Road, La Honda, CA 94022

County: San Mateo

Description of Project: The Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District (District) proposes to construct a new well as a new water source for agricultural use at the Harrington Grazing Unit in La Honda Creek Open Space Preserve (Preserve). The new well would replace an existing creek diversion and tie into existing water distribution lines and tanks. A new 5,000-gallon tank may be installed adjacent to existing water tanks depending on storage needs. The new well will supply water to troughs across the Preserve's conservation grazing area. The scope of work includes drilling an 8-inch test hole to a depth of 250 feet. Installation of the well includes a PVC Well Casing, a PVC Well Screen, steel casing in the top 20 feet of the well, and a sand pack and sanitary seal.

The District will contract with a C-57 licensed drilling company to drill the test hole and install the well components. A truck mounted drilling rig will be used and will access the site from the nearby existing rocked driveway across approximately 300 feet of open grazing land. A small concrete pad will be poured at the well location from a hand operated or tow-behind concrete mixer. Biological monitoring will be provided while equipment is driving on and off site and during drilling. Construction is anticipated to take 3 days. During construction, silt fencing and straw wattles would be installed for containment of sediment. Reseeding will occur in staging areas.

The well location is shown in Attachment 1: Project Location Map. The well will be installed at Option 1. If conditions are not conducive (i.e. water supply) at Option 1, the well will be installed at Option 2. Impacts and footprint will be the same at each location.

Exempt Status: The District has determined that the proposed Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article 19, Sections 15303 and 15304 of the State CEQA Guidelines as outlined below:

Section 15303 – New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures: Class 3 exempts the construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. This includes water and other utility



extensions. The proposed Project includes limited installation of small new equipment for a new agriculture well and minor modifications to connect to the existing water infrastructure system.

Section 15304 – Minor Alterations to Land: Class 4 exempts minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water or vegetation that do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees including minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored. The proposed Project will involve minor trenching that will be backfilled in order to dig the new well and connect to existing infrastructure.
