DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The project proposes to clean up and improve the maintenance yard in Columbia State Historic Park to provide an improved storage and staging area for both the vehicles utilized by the natural resources as well as heavy equipment. Work will:

- Cut down one (1) hazardous Black Walnut and one (1) rotting Oak tree, removing the stumps and associated debris;
- Use a backhoe or skid steer to excavate the top 2-3-inches of soil from the current approx. 45ft x 90-ft parking area to grade;
- Place 60 cubic yards of road base across the excavated area; and
- Run a hand compactor across the area to create a level surface.
