

Project Title: Common Landowner Transfer of up to 4,000 acre-feet (af) of Tulare Lake Basin DEPUT: Water Storage District's (Tulare Lake) 2024 State Water Project (SWP) Water to the Kern County Water Agency (Agency) on behalf of Lost Hills Water District (Lost Hills) and Berrenda Mesa Water District (Berrenda Mesa).

Location -- Specific: The Agency is a SWP contractor located in Kern County in the southern San Joaquin Valley. Lost Hills contracts for SWP water through the Agency and is in Kern County in the southern San Joaquin Valley. The SWP includes facilities located throughout the State of California. Tulare Lake is a SWP contractor located in Tulare County.

Location -- County: Kern and Tulare Counties.

Description of Activity: In 2024, Tulare Lake will transfer up to 4,000 af of its 2024 SWP water to the Agency for delivery to Lost Hills and Berrenda Mesa from California Aqueduct turnouts located in the Agency's service area.
