NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE ALTA CAPITAL MAINTENANCE PROJECT

WHAT IS PLANNED:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to preserve and extend the service life of the pavement along Interstate 80 between Colfax and Alta in Placer County. The proposed project includes improving existing fair and poor condition pavement to good condition with Capital Maintenance strategies and restore the functionality and extend the service life of drainage systems with either fair and/or poor condition culverts. The project also proposes to extend the lane separation taper at the State Route 174 eastbound separation off-ramp and the eastbound truck climbing lane at the Long Ravine Bridge. Other work includes rehabilitating and upgrading Transportation Management System elements, signs, sign structures, luminaries, guardrails, and vegetation control to the current standard.

The environment document, referred to as a Draft Initial Study Negative Declaration is available for review from June 11, 2024 to July 11, 2024 at the Colfax Public Library 10 W Church Street, Colfax, CA 95713.
