Title: Issuance of General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use – Lease 7785

Location: Sovereign land located in Steamboat Slough, adjacent to Solano County Assessor’s Parcel No. (APN) 0177-070-020 and 3464 Snug Harbor Drive on Ryer Island, Walnut Grove, Solano County

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use beginning June 7, 2024, for a term of 10 years, for the use of an existing boathouse, boat dock, deck, boat lift, one unattached piling, gangways, and bank protection.

Categorical Exemption:

CLASS 1, EXISTING FACILITIES (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15301)

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a 10-year General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use for the above-mentioned structures will not cause a physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemption applies.
