Project Title: RVR Agricultural Enterprises, LLC (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 241 North Vista Lane (Assessor's Parcel Number 014-360-13-00) in Trinity

County.

**County: Trinity County** 

<u>Project Description</u>: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code, Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a small mixed-light tier 1 commercial cannabis cultivation license.

<u>Project Activities:</u> The Project will consist of the development of 10,000 sf of existing mature light-deprivation cannabis canopy cultivation comprised of four 25'x100' greenhouses in a premise area measuring 49,440 sf, with reconfiguration of associated support buildings totaling 5,800 sf. Greenhouses are permitted and will be permanent structures and will not be disassembled. Water for the Project would be provided from a municipal connection to TCWD #1. An onsite septic system would serve the Project's domestic wastewater needs. Access to the Project site would be via North Vista Lane. All proposed construction of new structures will utilize hand tools exclusively. Grading will occur utilizing no more than a leveler pulled behind a farm tractor, being that there are a small number of areas requiring minor leveling. Heavy equipment will be operated by a licensed contractor and will occur during the dry season and outside of the nesting season for raptors and birds (September-October). Once the proposed greenhouses are installed, they will be permanent structures and will not be disassembled. All greenhouses will be light deprivation only and will not utilize artificial lighting. Road improvement components are not necessary.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is consistent with the local jurisdiction community plan and/or zoning designations. CEQA mandates that the project is consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. The project activity fits within the parameters included in CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 and the activity does not require additional CEQA analysis.
