NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Title: Letter of Non-Objection to Perform Carson Wandering Skipper Surveys

Location: State-owned school and sovereign lands in Honey Lake, Lassen County

Description: Request for staff and consultants to perform pedestrian surveys along the lake margins for the Carson Wandering Skipper, a federally endangered species that is known to occur at Honey Lake.
