Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Ordinance No. 1736 (2024 Series) - Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 25402.1(h)(2) and Section 10-106 of the Building Energy Efficiency Standards, the City adopted an Ordinance that amends Title 15 of the City's Municipal Code, adding local amendments to the California Energy Code for major additions and/or alterations of existing buildings to have lower energy use and operational greenhouse gas emissions than otherwise required by the California Energy Code. The Ordinance includes findings that the amendments are "cost effective" and use less energy than the standard state requirements. The ordinance only applies to major additions and/or alterations of 500 or more square feet in existing single-family residential buildings.
