Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the environmental review process for the SFPUC City Water Distribution Division Campus Project at 2000 Marin Street. The Local Development Review (LDR) Program reviews land use projects and plans to ensure consistency with our mission and state planning priorities. The following comments are based on our review of the June 2024 Draft MND.

Please note this correspondence does not indicate an official position by Caltrans on this project and is for informational purposes only.

#### **Project Understanding**

The proposed project would involve the construction of a new City Water Distribution Division campus at 2000 Marin Street in the Bayview District of San Francisco. The existing buildings at the site will be demolished and six new buildings that will be used for operation facilities and administrative offices totaling 370,850 square feet. This project site is in vicinity of the I-280 off-ramp at Cesar Chavez St.

#### **Construction-Related Impacts**

Project work that requires movement of oversized or excessive load vehicles on State roadways requires a transportation permit that is issued by Caltrans. To apply, please visit Caltrans Transportation Permits ([link](#)).
