The project area involves an approximately 4000 acres of which 1200+/- treatable acres in the Grizzly Flats, Sly Park, Omo Ranch, Strawberry communities located in El Dorado County, Ca. See attached map for specific locations.

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The currently contemplated activities of the proposed project include removal of accumulated woody debris, dead trees, and incidental vegetation on 1200+/- private parcels to ensure long term fire fuels are reduced. In addition, the project would conduct site preparation and planting to re-establish forest cover on these private lands. Timely removal of the trees and incidental vegetation and subsequent site preparation is necessary to reduce the immediate risk to the existing private landowners as well as allow for future recovery treatments and/or redevelopment.
