The Imperial County Department of Public Works has been awarded preliminary engineering funds for the development of a Local Roadway Safety Plan (LRSP) for Imperial County. The LRSP will focus on identifying opportunities to improve traffic safety on roadways that support and enhance the finding of the Imperial County Systemic Safety Analysis Report with a focus on the Safe Systems approach that uses each of the four E's of safety: Engineering, Enforcement, Education and Emergency Services. The LRSP will analyze collision data throughout Imperial County roads and provide a framework to systemically identify and analyze safety problems and recommend safety improvements.
