Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The City of Santa Maria Utilities Department is proposing to develop a new potable water well, designated Well Number 15 (herein referred to as Well No. 15 or Well 15). The new Well No. 15 would be added to an existing municipal water supply network of six active wells and is designed to provide approximately 2,200 gallons per minute ("gpm") of potable water. The proposed new well site would occupy approximately 0.35-acre (123 feet by 123 feet) of an active agricultural field immediately adjacent to the Santa Maria Airport airfield, northeast of the 11th Street and E Street intersection.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Potentially significant adverse environmental impacts were identified in the areas of Aesthetics/Visual Resources, Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources and Geology and Soils.

Mitigation was created for each of the items listed above, and include but are not limited to: light shielding, fugitive dust control measures, diesel exhaust control measures, California Red-Legged Frog avoidance, measures to enact during inadvertent discovery of human remains or archaeological resources, measures to enact if inadvertent discovery of tribal cultural resources occurs and preliminary geotechnical recommendations.
