NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION MONTEREY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Monterey County Housing & Community Development has prepared a draft Mitigated Negative Declaration, pursuant to the requirements of CEQA, for a Combined Development Permit (Big Sur Land Trust, File Number PLN150805) at 3400 Red Wolf Drive, Carmel (APN 416-011-007-000) (see description below).

The Mitigated Negative Declaration and Initial Study, as well as referenced documents, are available for review at Monterey County Housing & Community Development – Planning, 1441 Schilling Pl South 2nd Floor, Salinas, California. The Planning Commission will consider this proposal at a future meeting in the Monterey County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 168 West Alisal St, Salinas, California. Written comments on this Mitigated Negative Declaration will be accepted from **June 25, 2024** to **July 25, 2024**. Comments can also be made during the public hearing.

Project Description: Combined Development Permit consisting of: 1) Coastal Administrative Permit and Design Approval to allow construction of an approximately 4,649 square foot two-story single family dwelling, with an attached 1,499 square foot garage, an 205 square foot mechanical room, and associated site improvements including a, driveway, hardscape and conversion of a test well to a domestic production well; 2) Coastal Development Permit to allow development within environmentally sensitive habitat; 3) Coastal Development Permit to allow 195 square feet of development on slopes in excess of 30%.

We welcome your comments during the 30-day public review period. You may submit your comments in hard copy to the name and address above. The Agency also accepts comments via e-mail or facsimile but requests that you follow these instructions to ensure that the Agency has received your comments.
