**PROJECT LOCATION:** The Crescenta Valley Water District (District) is located in the Crescenta Valley area of Los Angeles County, California. The service area encompasses the unincorporated communities of La Crescenta and Montrose, as well as a small portion of the Cities of Glendale and La Cañada-Flintridge.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project referred to internally as Recycled Water Feasibility Study. The purpose of the Project is to determine the best method to bring recycled water into District's service area to be used for irrigation and potentially recharging the Verdugo Basin.

**PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT:** The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on June 24, 2024, and determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The Crescenta Valley Water District will be carrying out the Project.
