FORM "A" NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Resmar Existing Utility Facility Infrastructure Maintenance

Project Eliminating Tree Encroachments 2022.11

The scope of work for this utility infrastructure maintenance project does not expand operations of this existing facility. The project involves removal of trees that do not fall under any local or state protections or permit requirements, which are encroaching into Helix Water District, San Diego County Sanitation District, and SDG&E existing utility facility easements. Trees are generally hazardous to utility facility infrastructure, in particular root intrusion risks causing critical pipeline failure or leakage and denigration. Further, trees within an easement obstruct access to critical facilities existing within the easement.

For Helix Water District, the removal of the encroachments within this easement enables crucial facility maintenance and access in an emergency, due to the age of the pipeline (installed in 1966), and its material, which is known to be fragile (asbestos cement). This existing segment of Helix Water District's 8-inch water main is a critical, nonlooped feed, and serves several residential dwellings.

The initial work commenced on November 7, 2023 and was completed on January 15, 2024. The work took place outside of the Bird Nesting Season and there were no protected tree species removed. A tree removal permit was not required. Upon further inspection, three additional trees were identified as hazardous to the integrity of the existing facilities. A bird survey was conducted on June 21, 2024 and a licensed biologist certified in a written report that no nests were present. The tree removal was scheduled within 5 days of the bird survey, on June 26, 2024. Additionally, there were no protected tree species removed and a tree removal permit was not required.
