Project Title: Creek Safety Fence (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ELD-48978-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Carson Creek, in the County of El Dorado, State of California; Latitude 38.64283, Longitude -121.07654; 980 Stonebridge Street El Dorado Hill, CA 95762; Assessor's Parcel Number: 117-030-013-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number ELD-48978-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Mohammed Saleem.

The project is limited to installing a 150-foot-long solid wooden fence from Stonebridge Road along the eastern property line. Metal posts with a 4-inch diameter will be placed every 8 feet and secured with cement. The fence will be between 6 and 7 feet tall with individual boards between $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ inches thick. The fence follows the drainage with two crossings, one north of the pond and one south of the pond and existing dam wall. Each crossing will have a freeboard of 12-inches from the high-water mark. Dead and fallen trees will be removed or cut before installing the fence.
