Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project would be located within the 13.88-acre campus of Golden West MS. The proposed project would involve the construction of additional school facilities on approximately 3.7 acres in the northeastern and eastern portions of the campus for the purpose of expanding the campus from grades 7 and 8 to grades 6 to 8 commencing in the 2025-26 school year. The project site will also include an approximately 2-acre, District-owned parcel for placement of export material that will be located approximately 300 feet north of the campus on the east side of De Ronde Drive. In total, the proposed project would consist of 5.7 acres of District-owned land.

AIR QUALITY

AQ-1: District to comply with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's best management practices for reducing construction emissions of uncontrolled fugitive dust and fine inhalable particulate matter.

BIO-1: implement a preconstruction survey for nesting burrowing owl.

BIO-2: survey for Swainson's hawk nesting activity during the Swainson's hawk nesting season (March 1 to August 31).

BIO-3: conduct a preconstruction survey for nesting raptors.

BIO-4: conduct a bat habitat assessment for suitable bat roosting habitat prior to any construction activities.
