Project Title: King City Riverbed Wildfire Prevention Plan

Project Applicant: City of King

Project Location (include county): Salinas Riverbed area south of River Drive; San Lorenzo Creek corridor east of Rio Vista Drive (Monterey County)

Project Description: The King City Riverbed Wildfire Prevention Plan (RWPP or plan) (proposed project) serves as a framework for a long-term fire resiliency and prioritizes hazard reduction projects along portions of the Salinas River and San Lorenzo Creek in or near the City of King, California. The plan achieves the two following goals: 1) provides guidance and strategies to increase the wildfire resilience of the community; and, 2) protects and enhances the wildlife habitat and ecological value of the project area. The primary implementation measure recommended by the RWPP is the creation of a fuel break on the edge of the Salinas Riverbed to protect homes and businesses and prevent a wildland fire from becoming an urban conflagration.
