## WEST WOODBRIDGE ROAD STABILIZATION

### Project Description

#### **Project Location:**

**West Woodbridge Road:** West end to 6,000 feet east of west end. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

#### **Project Justification:**

**Woodbridge Road** is heavily damaged. Extensive pavement failures are present within both lanes. Extensive pavement failures in both lanes. Failure and undermining in the shoulder areas are also present. Large dips in the road have created an extremely uneven driving surface.

The road has been chip sealed once in the last seven years. Rip Rap and shoulder protection was placed in various areas along the specified segment in May of 2023.

#### **Scope of Work:**

The project will consist of:

1. Clearing and grubbing vegetation in shoulder areas.
2. Pulverizing in place approximately 6,000 Linear Feet of existing road section at approximately 22-foot-wide, at varying depths of 8 to 10 inches.
3. Building up shoulders on north and south sides with Rip Rap and Aggregate Base (AB).
4. Building up road section with Class II AB, grade shape and compact.
5. Applying organic stabilization material to road section, grade and compact.

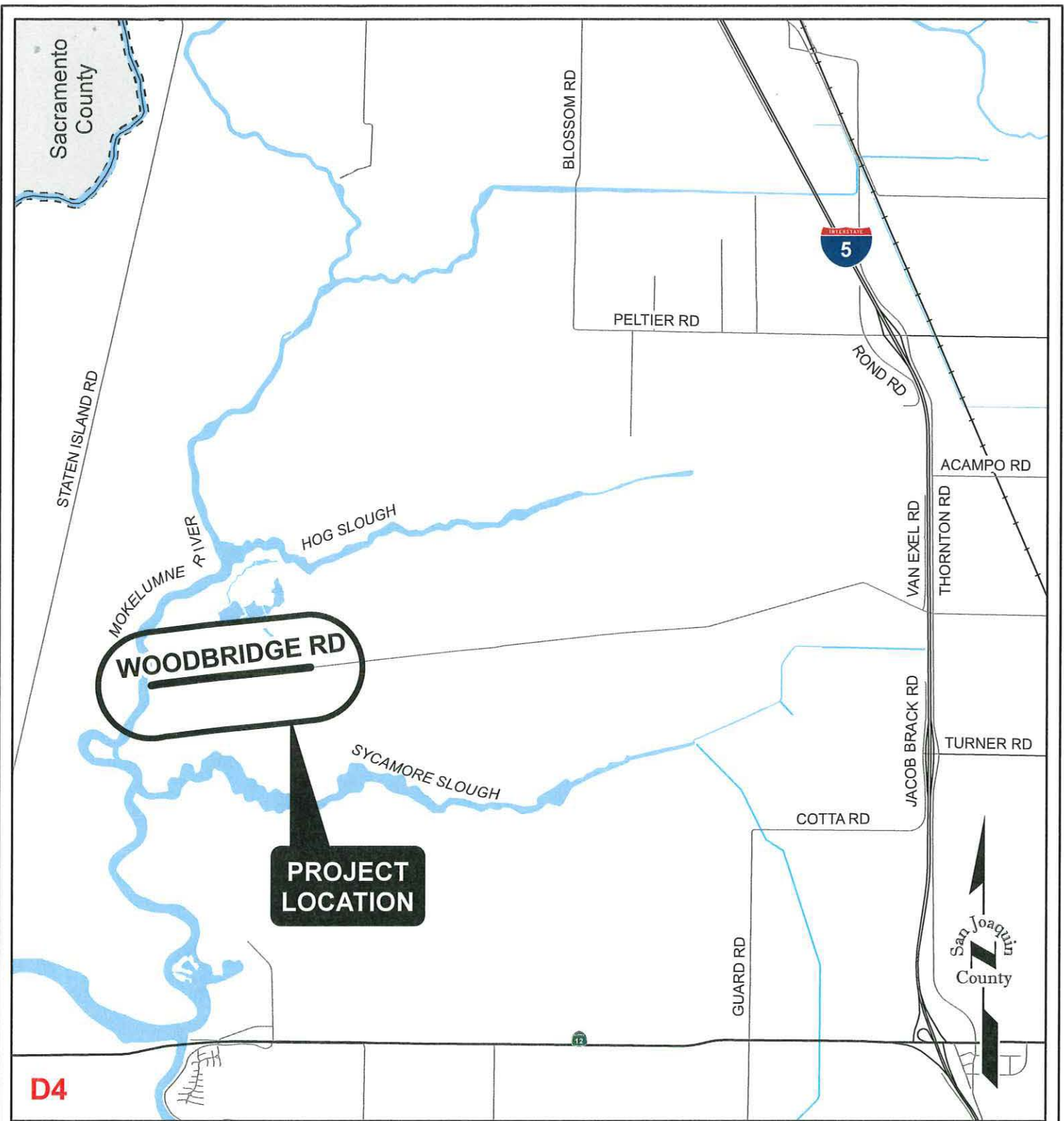
#### **Environmental Setting:**

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **agricultural with single family homes.**

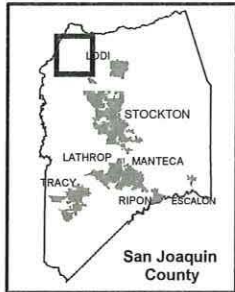
**There are many large trees adjacent to the project area.** Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15<sup>th</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### **Beneficiaries:**

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
