## 99 EAST FRONTAGE ROAD CURB REPAIR

### Project Description

#### **Project Location:**

**East 99 Frontage Road:** Between Morada Lane and Gnekow Drive. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

#### **Project Justification:**

The Sidewalk Repair Program was first established and implemented in 2003. This annual program addresses the need to repair sections of existing curbs, gutters and sidewalks that are either broken or displaced to such an extent that it creates a safe hazard. With the additional availability of funds, in addition to the Sidewalk Repair Program, this project will help to address additional concerns.

The concrete curbs along the shoulder in the southbound lane of 99 East Frontage Road provides a safety barrier for traveling vehicular traffic and embankment erosion control. This project will address the need to repair sections of existing concrete curbs that have been broken, displaced, or have been completely missing to such an extent that it no longer provides safety for the traveling vehicular traffic. This program will be processed through the Job Order Contracts (JOC).

#### **Scope of Work:**

The project will consist of:

1. Removing and replacing of identified segments of existing concrete curbs. The existing curbs are saw-cut and removed, then new curbs are installed, superimposed on existing pavement to match. The work involves the removal and replacement of 1,397 linear feet of concrete curbs at approximately 34 separate locations throughout county areas in Road District 4.

#### **Environmental Setting:**

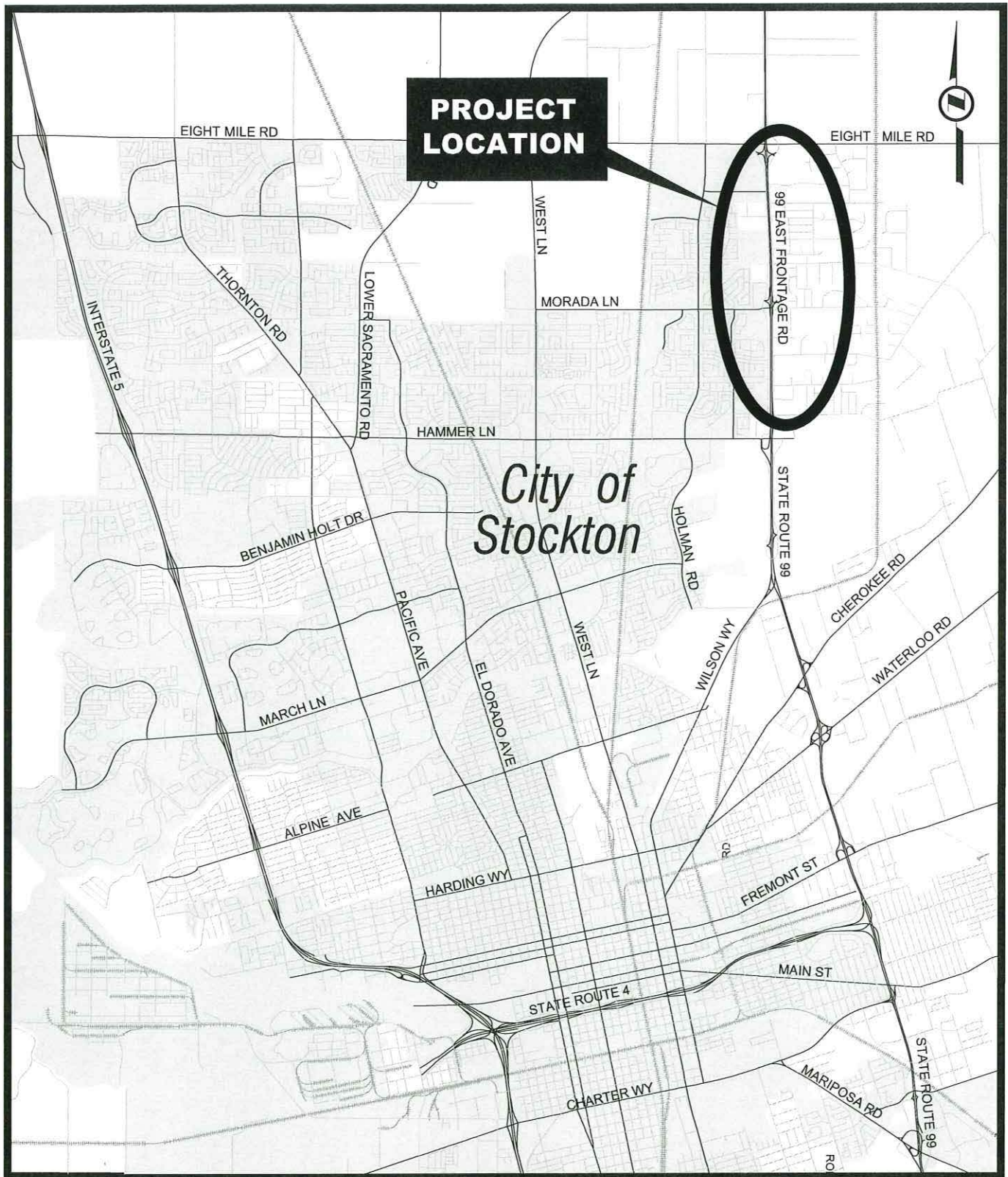
In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with commercial uses.**

**There are many large trees adjacent to the project area.** Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15<sup>th</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### **Beneficiaries:**

The public will see increased safety for vehicular travel within the project limits, as there will be new curbs in place.

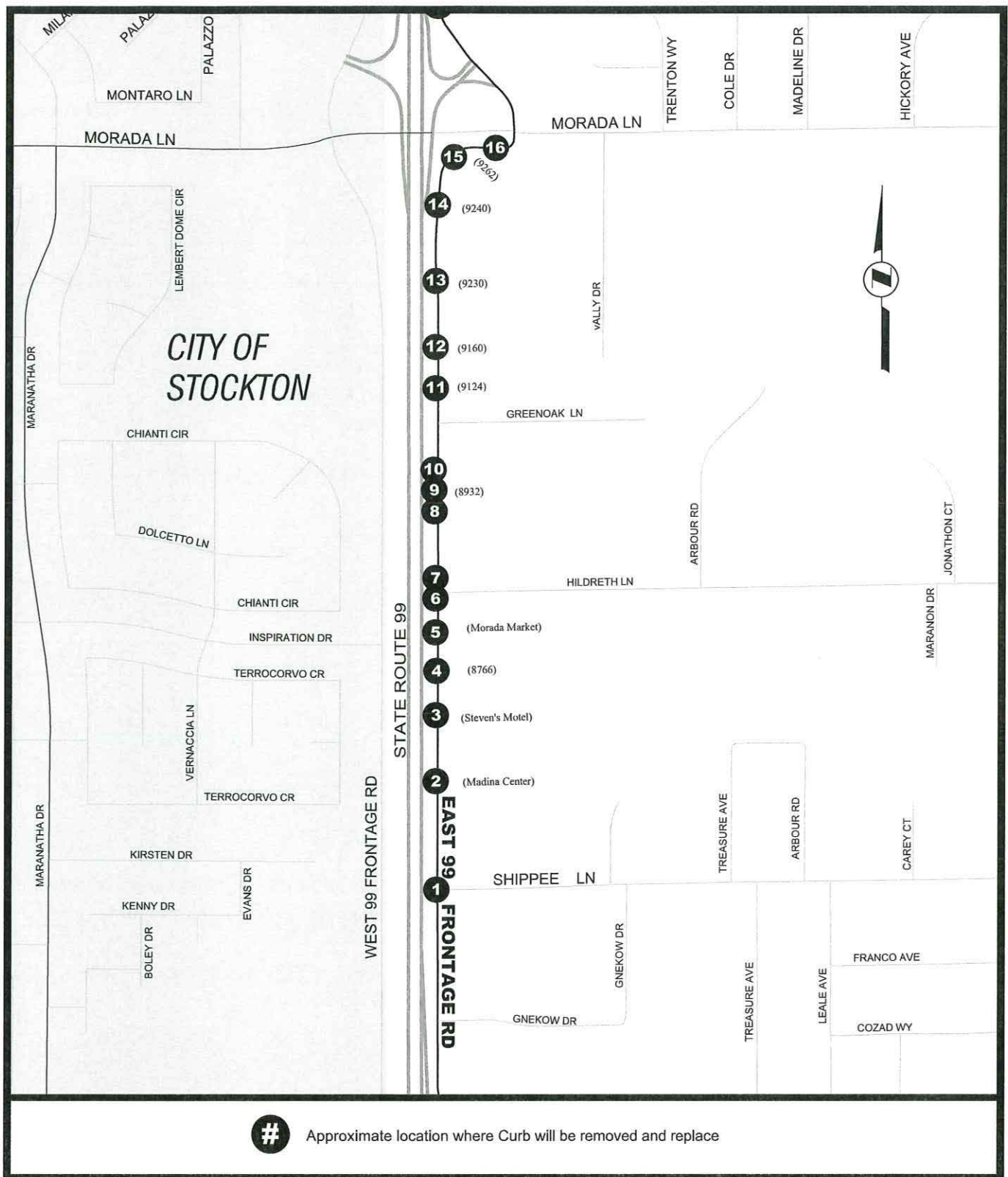




VICINITY MAP

(Shippee Lane to Eight Mile Road)

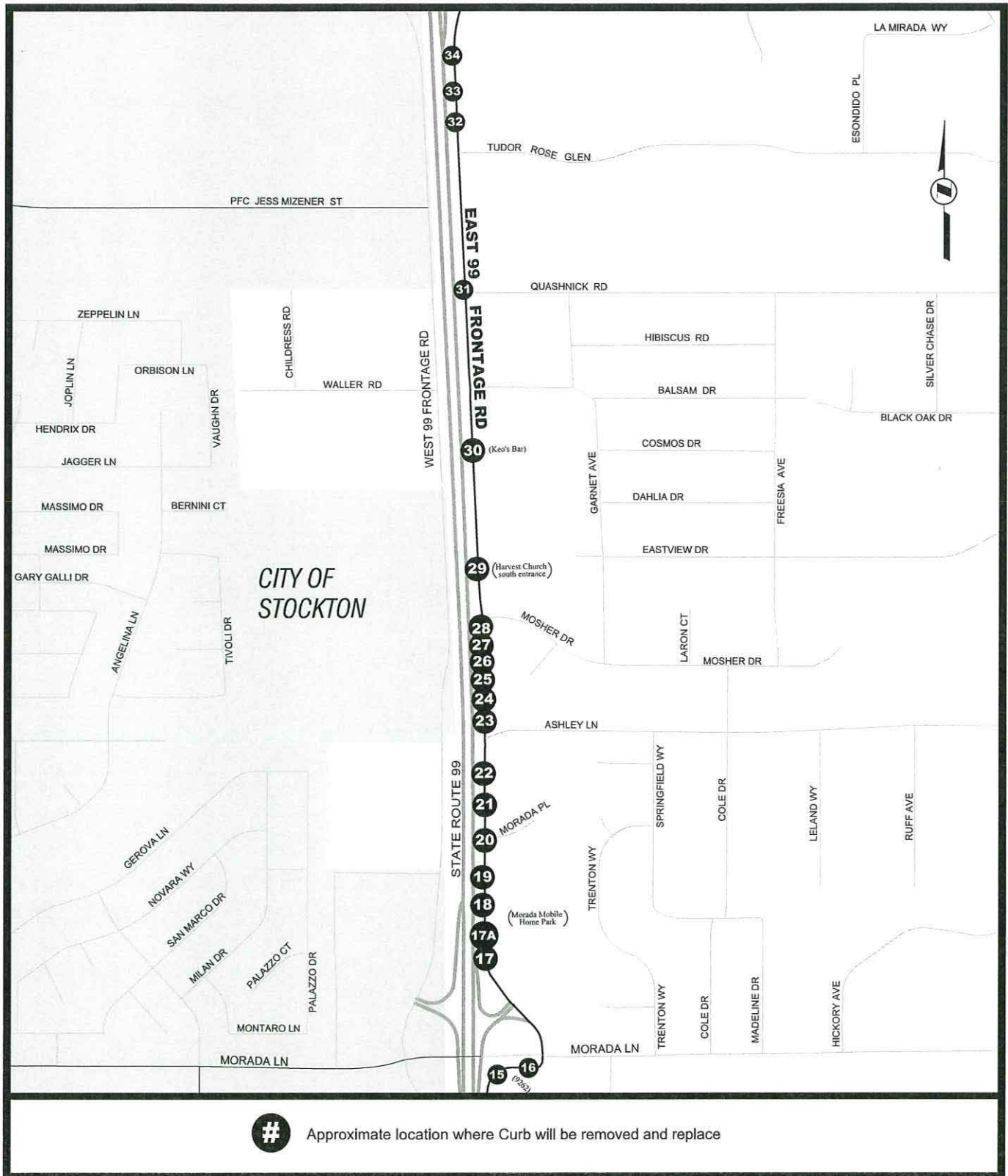
