Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Mariposa County Public Works Department proposes to replace the existing bridge at School House Road Bridge over Owens Creek, located roughly 1.2 miles southwest of the community of Catheys Valley. The new bridge will be a 2-lane, 40-foot long, single span cast-in-place concrete, post tension slab bridge that meets current design standards. A temporary construction easement is proposed to the north of the bridge. Any permanent ROW acquisition, if needed, would be small slivers of property along the road and would not restrict use of adjacent properties and would not adversely affect property values. The bridge is expected to close to traffic during construction and detour signs will be posted. The detour length is 5 miles, a 7-minute detour. Residents and emergency service providers will be notified in advance. The project would have no impact on aesthetics, agricultural land, air quality, energy, greenhouse gas emissions, hydrology, land use/planning, mineral resources, noise, population/housing, recreation, and wildfire. The Project would have a less than significant impact on archeological/historical, biological resources, public services/facilities, geology/soils, toxic/hazardous materials, traffic/circulation, and tribal cultural resources.

The CEQA analysis did not identify any significant or potentially significant effects resulting from the proposed Project. This bridge replacement project would have temporary, less than significant impacts on the environment.
