Project Description: The project consists of a Zoning Administrator Permit which allows the placement of two temporary medical trailers in a parking lot on the Palo Alto Medical Foundation campus located at 3200 Kearney Street. The medical trailers would be used temporarily by the Palo Alto Medical Foundation to provide Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) and Computed Tomography (CT) scanning services to patients while the adjacent medical office undergoes interior tenant improvements.
