The improvements consist of weed kill the roadway, selected AC pavement repairs and application of Type II slurry seal with new roadway striping, markings and legends.

ADMINISTRATIVE DETERMINATION: Categorically Exempt from CEQA review per CEQA Statute §15301(c) Class 1 (Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities).

WHY EXEMPT: The Project does not expand the existing use and will not have any significant environmental impact.

EXEMPT STATUS: Exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Statute §15301(c) Class 1, for the repair and maintenance of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities, such as the various residential streets in the City of Bell Gardens public right-of-way in the subject Project, are categorically exempt from CEQA review.
