**Project Title:** Tom Green Crossing (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SHA-44931-R11)

**Project Location (Shasta County):** The project is located off Tom Green Mine Road in Shasta County on an unnamed tributary to Clear Creek, tributary to Whiskeytown Lake in Shasta County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 046-290-018-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SHA-44931-R11, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Mr. Wesso.

The project includes the replacement of a filled crossing with an armored fill crossing, installation of three armored rolling dips that are associated with the crossing approaches, and maintenance activities.

**Public Agency Approving Project:** CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

**Person or Public Agency Carrying Out Project:** Mr. Jordan Wesso

**Exempt Status:**

Statutory Exemption.

Categorical Exemptions. Types:

**Class 2; California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15302 (c),** Replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.

**Reasons why project is exempt:** The project is a result of a Notice of Violation issued on May 19, 2022, for violations of Fish and Game Code related to illegal cannabis cultivation activities that impacted an unnamed stream tributary to Clear Creek. The armored fill crossing and armored rolling dips replace the existing structures, without expansion of capacity, and prevent adverse impacts to the stream and fish and wildlife resources.
