Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Earth disturbing activities on slopes greater than 5% that includes clearing of vegetation (mixed oak woodland, semi-natural grassland, and ruderal land), earthmoving, and installation and maintenance of erosion control measures associated with the development and operation of 0.73-acres of new vineyard (0.63 net planted acres) situated in the Caymus Creek Drainage.

The approximate 40.3-acre project site (Assessor's Parcel No. 032-070-024), is located on the east side of Silverado Trail approximately 0.25 miles north of its intersection with Yountville Crossroad, in the Rector Reservoir area of Napa County.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

- Potential impacts to Purple Needlegrass Grassland, a native grassland that is a sensitive natural plant community. Mitigation would include replacement at a 3:1 ratio and preservation.
- Potential impacts to oak woodland and associated vegetation cover canopy. Mitigation will include replanting/replacement and permanent preservation.
