**Project Location, Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries:**

The project includes the following components within the City of Trinidad and County of Humboldt:

1. Curb ramp and sidewalk replacement/upgrades, installation of rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFBs), curb/driveway extensions, and/or signage & striping at the following locations:
  - Location 1: Main Street at View Avenue
  - Location 2: Edwards Street at Hector Street
  - Location 3: Edwards Street at Galindo Street
  - Location 4: Main Street at Scenic Drive
  - Location 5: Van Wycke Street at Galindo Street
  
2. Replacing existing guardrail systems, end treatments and signs, and installing vegetation control mats at the following two (2) locations:
  - Location 1: Scenic Drive, south of Langford Road
  - Location 2: Patrick's Point Drive, north of Ocean Avenue
  
3. The installation of edgelines and improved striping and signage along roadways at the following locations, including some minor pavement widening/replacement:
  - Location 1: Trinidad Frontage Road, from N. Westhaven Drive to End
  - Location 2: Stagecoach Road, from City Limits to Main Street
  - Location 3: Westhaven Drive, from City Limits to Trinidad Frontage Road
  - Location 4: Edwards Street
  - Location 5: Scenic Drive
  
4. New speed humps, signage, pavement signage/markings on Ocean Avenue and View Avenue

The project will enhance pedestrian routes and roadway safety to and from core municipal centers, maintaining existing roadways and pedestrian facilities. The project will benefit resident and visiting public in Trinidad, California.

**Reasons why project is exempt:**

All project components are categorically exempt under Section 15301 – Existing Facilities. Existing streets, sidewalks, curb ramps, gutters, crosswalks, driveways, and guardrail are facilities that will be repaired and treated with minor alternations. These are existing public facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use. The project includes the repair and minor alterations to pedestrian facilities to meet ADA requirements and improve safety for pedestrians. These are existing pedestrian facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use. The upgraded guardrail systems will be a reconstruction of an existing facility, also involving negligible expansion of use.
