Project Title: California Park Lakes (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. BUT-33187-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at California Park, in the City of Chico, Butte County, California; Latitude 39.75400, Longitude -121.78800 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number BUT-33187-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Park Association as represented by Martha Ellington.

The Project will dredge accumulated sediment and remove vegetation throughout the California Park Lakes System. A maximum of 1,200 cubic yards of sediment will be removed from the lake each year. The project will also involve vegetation control, facilities maintenance repair, and minor erosion control.
