Biological Resources - Nesting birds could be impacted on the recharge basin property during ground disturbing activities. Mitigation includes a survey. If nests are found, then an avoidance buffer will be established until a biologist has determined the nest is no longer active.

Cultural Resources - Historical or archaeological resources could be discovered during ground disturbing activities. Mitigation includes monitoring during ground disturbance, stopping work in the event of a discovery, consulting a qualified archaeologist, and implementing appropriate measures to evaluate, and protect the resource.

Paleontological Resources - Paleontological resources could be discovered during ground disturbing activities. Mitigation includes stopping work, consulting a qualified paleontologist and implementing appropriate measures.

Noise - Construction would result in a temporary increase in noise. Mitigation includes construction equipment mufflers and placement of construction equipment away from noise sensitive receptors.

Tribal Cultural Resources - Tribal Cultural Resources could be discovered during groundwater disturbing activities. Mitigation includes monitoring, avoidance upon discovery, reporting and collaboration on appropriate treatment methods.
