Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Major use permit to obtain five (5) A- Type 3 Outdoor cultivation licenses consisting of 5 acres within three separate areas of outdoor cultivation; three (3) A-Type 2 Small Outdoor cultivation licenses consisting of (3) 10,000 sf of outdoor cultivation areas, and one (1) A-Type 13 Self Transportation Only Self Distribution license.
Project proposes five greenhouses for immature plants and several small sheds.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Aesthetics - some potential for light migration and visibility from a public road. Screening of cultivation areas required. Blackout screening required inside all greenhouses and transparent / translucent buildings.
Air Quality - dust during and after site preparation and odors during harvest season. Water on all disturbed areas during site disturbance. Gravel on driveways, parking areas. Fragrant plants along south-eastern portion of the cultivation area to mask cannabis odors.
Cultural Resources - inadvertent discovery of sensitive cultural items of significance. Training of employees to spot potentially significant items and relics. Notification of Tribe, County, Archaeologist required upon discovery. Notification and work stoppage if human remains are inadvertently discovered during site preparation and over life of project.
Noise - maximum noise thresholds measured at property line during site preparation and life of project.
Wildfire - upgrade interior driveway to Public Resource Code 4290 standards; install 4,000 gallon water tank for use for fire suppression; water tender on site during construction; 100 feet of defensible space around all buildings.
