LOCATION: Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The project proposes to replace the warped and rotting board and batten siding on the Chaw’se Regional Indian Museum at Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park to better secure the building from pest and water intrusion, to protect irreplaceable artifacts and cultural items and improve energy efficiency. Work will:

- Remove existing bat and board as well as wooden 1-in x 8-in. horizontal spacers encircling the exterior of the building;
- Install approx. 3,500 sq. ft. of Allura vertical siding cement board using various sizes as needed the reduce number vertical seems;
- Purchase all siding and trim boards in the factory color of Sable Brown;
- Replace the ADA handrail on the second story with a new railing and spacers in the same style and configuration as existing, with minor modification to allow siding boards to run full length of wall; and
- Paint all new railing, exposed nails, and any damage with color to match existing siding.
